This document is intended to provide more information around the possible Source of Wealth and Source of Funds information and documentation which may be required as part of our due diligence, or enhanced due diligence, processes.

Source of Funds

Source of Wealth Sale of property - Company sale or sale of interest held in a company	 The following must be recorded: Name & address of company sold/sale of interest Total sale price of company sold/sale of interest % of share sold by the Customer Nature of business of the company and Date of sale 	 One of the following must be obtained: Signed letter from Solicitor engaged for the sale Signed letter from UK regulated accountant or Copy of the contract of sale and evidence of investment monies on a Bank statement
